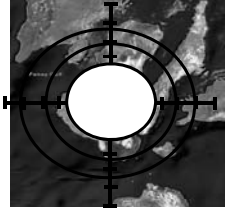

- **NPA's active in the province.**
 - **A. Overran a PC detachment in 1 of our major towns**
 - **B. doing teach-ins in the hinterlands**
 - **C. established clinics in most of our inland barangays**

Negros Oriental Response

- **A. Military operations**
- **B. Provincial Government brought to the level of the barangays and among other things put up community high schools and community hospitals with the help of mayor and barangay captains. With Silliman University Extension Service**

Primary community hospital

- A ten-bed bamboo-nipa building ran by 2 doctors and nurse, some midwives and barangay health workers
 - The hospital had a catchment of 12 barangays with the barangay captains of the host hospital as the chairman of the hospital board
 - The hospital is capable of extending primary health care and primary hospital care.
- Funding: mainly provincial funds, with barangay contributions and the municipality helping out.

1992

- Devolution of Hospital Care :

– **CREATION OF HOSPITAL BOARDS AT THE PROVINCIAL HOSPITAL AND 5 DISTRICT HOSPITALS THROUGH EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 92-16 with SANGGUNIAN PANLALAWIGAN RESOLUTION NO. 278.**

Composition Of The **HOSPITAL BOARD**

- **Chairman:** ☐ **SP Member representing the political district where the hospital is located**
- **Vice-chairman:** ☐ **Chief of the District Hospital**
- **Members:** ☐ **Municipal Mayor from catchment area**
 ☐ **NGO representative**
 ☐ **Religious group representative PMS, PHA**

Functions of the BOARD

- **Assist the Provincial Governor in the financial management of the District Hospital.**
- **Review and endorse the budgetary requirements of the District Hospital.**
- **Devise a mechanism for internal control**
- **Ensure the participation of Local Government Units and community involvement in hospital service.**

1. **Organized the Women's and Men's Auxiliary group**
2. **Established the diagnostic center and dialysis center**
3. **Scholarship grants to medical students (Silliman University Medical School)**

- 4. Residency training program in OB Gyne and Surgery**
- 5. Putting up infirmaries in the poblacion of each town with primary hospital care and BEMOC capabilities**
- 6. Institutionalize the ILHZ: Managed by the District Health Board, with mayors of the catchment towns. The governor as chairman.**




